With lds rarely dropping below 100 a massive 150 finishing in the final race of 1985 at Blackheath. This was time for Tom Everitt to call it a day and thankfully Sandy Risley took over the organisation on behalf of Forbanks who had joined the league in 1985 and is still doing a fine job to this day.

The venues were now down to a routine six having ceased Leyton Marsh, and the New Eltham course with the departure from London of Mollins giving us 2 races at each Forbanks, Blackheath and Victoria Park. 1986 to 1988 saw the fields drop slightly, surprisingly enough more due to the running boom with a lot more mid-week events being staged.

The following couple of years saw new teams P&O, LT Met, Westminster (the old GLC) and Dartford, again not all of them seeing out the course and apart from 1992 numbers gradually increasing.

This trend has continued well into 1995 the 20th anniversary of the league with Sandy still doing a good job organising events.

The final race of 1995 at Forbanks will be the 138th of the competition - anyone out there done them all? I dont think so.

ANOTHER INTERESTING RESULT AND REPORT :

ASSEMBLY LEAGUE

The Assembly League was formed in 1976 by Les Jones on behalf of the London Postal Region, it came about from a twice yearly match between business house teams L.P.R and Molins the latter being a cigarette machine manufacturers based in South East London. Several LPR members were associated with Eton Manor AC and likewise Molins with Cambridge Harriers. These four teams plus Hermes British Telecom who also had matches with LPR were the five teams that made up the league for the first season. In the early years the league programme was made up of eight races plus a non scoring end of the season yacht handicap run held in conjunction with the presentation at Blackheath. The venues being two races at each of Blackheath, New Eltham, Bexley and Leyton Marsh.

The second season saw the introduction of a new course at Mill Hill also the addition of Kent AC to the competition and the following year another business house team AQUILA joined giving the league a make up of three clubs and three business house teams. 1978 was also the year of Les Jones organisation of the league with Tom Everitt taking over the reigns for 1979.

The next few years saw a steady increase in numbers and new teams joining the league namely Victoria Park Harriers, this giving us a new traffic free venue. 1981 saw BTPOHQ another strong business house teams entry to the league and in the August race at Blackheath a then record field of 124 toeing the line, this increased to 134 the following August at Victoria Park.

During the years 1982 to 1985 several more teams appeared, some be it briefly - Terbow Sports, Roan OBs, North London AC, Stansfield and Loughton AC. In 1985 the fixtures were reduced to six with the yacht handicap having ceased in 1983, it also saw the introduction of the individual championship for the best performance over the complete season. 1985 also saw the entry of another strong business house team to the league namely Stock Exchange who generously put up the trophy for the winning business house team, this giving the league a full set of trophies adding to the original clubs George Meopham Trophy, the Les Jones shield for the winning 'B' team and the individual winners shield donated by Kent AC.

Goldring led the Stock Exchange team to an easy win in the business houses section but otherwise it looks like Ladywell based Kent AC who will be picking up all the awards in the final fixture at Beckenham next month. They comfortably lead both club and 'B' team sections and Len Reilly looks set for the individual title.

Goldring also won the corresponding fixture exactly eight years ago and back in 1966 was a 13 year-old Steve Backley (minus his javelin).
